What do we know?

Businesses are reporting:

- The quality of recruitment has not improved.
- There are skills shortages across sectors.
- Paying 16-year-olds the Real Living Wage is impacting the demand for wage increases across the business.
- A societal shift has given rise to a reluctancy for weekend and antisocial hour working.
- Hospitality, tourism & service sectors still seen as low skilled / low paid.
- Seasonality challenges.

What do we know?



Our young people are struggling. In a recent survey of North Highland pupils for the Focus North Conference, we asked "what personal skills would you like help with to prepare for the future?"

• Alarmingly 52.6% said Confidence & 41.6% Stress or Anxiety Management & 49% Motivation 34.6% said Communication

DYW North Highland hosts workshops to boost young people's confidence, helping them identify their key skills, and shares valuable insights to help them with their future.





The Caithness Business Fund's mission is to promote the economic growth of Caithness and North Sutherland by supporting new and existing businesses and developing the skill base to meet new challenges.

The Caithness Business Fund provided support for 10 apprenticeships in the Caithness and North Sutherland Region in 2023.

Eligible SMEs in Caithness and North Sutherland can access grants up to £24,500 (over a maximum of 3 years) from the Fund to help with employment and associated training costs for an accredited apprenticeship within their business


